If you wish to place the plugins in the plugin path of most applications you will have to add the 8BF files to the plug-ins folder and this is in the privileged area of 'program files'. If you are copying the 8BF files and you are using a basic account (not admin) then you will be asked for the admin account, this is normal.

Sampler plug-ins

The full plug-in sets include many different plug-ins. If the plug-in set includes many plug-ins (i.e. volume 1, 2, 3, etc) then the sampler / demo set will include one full use (not a demo) plug-in from that set.

If the plug-in set includes only 1 or 2 plug-ins then the demo / sampler set will not contain the plug-in related to that set but one of the samplers from the bigger sets. The plug-in functionality might vary (a lot) but there are many similarities between the plug-ins such as all the effects / output / transparency / color settings / randomization features - I hope you get a good idea of the plug-in even if it is not 'the actual release' for that volume.

Paint Shop Pro notes

The plug-in folder may or may not exist. If there appears to be no plug-in folder:
1) Start up PSP
2) file > preferences
3) file locations
4) select plug-ins
Check to see if there is a plug-in folder, copy the 8BF plugins to this folder. If the folder is not set, create a folder for the 8BF plugins and then set the file location preference to this location. You may also need to set the plug-ins enabled check box to ON

General use

The plug-ins all work generally the same way (beyond their actual effect of blurring or smearing etc).

The plug-ins all come with 100 output / blending modes such as inverse, frame, tiles etc; effects modes where the plug-in effect becomes a blur or sepia effect (20 are included); transparency settings for use with layers and layer effects; color sliders to manipulate the color channels in 16 million odd ways; post effect settings such as applying a gradient overlay or blend in 1000s of different ways (click the post-rnd button to randomize this).

To experiment with the blends, click the blend button. To randomize many of the settings, click the extreme button. To randomize the color sliders, click the color button. To save and open presets, click the save and open buttons.

Scripting / actions

The plug-ins can now be used in the actions palette / Photoshop Use the record command to record the plug-in use and save to an action. Use in batches etc
